Online registrations for NetSetGo - GO competition players open on 1 March 2020

- Team Manager/Coach submits Team Registration form with names of all players intending to play at time of registration. Players must complete their registration a fortnight prior to competition commencing.
- An adult contact name and mobile number must be listed on Team Registration Sheet who will be the liaison for all communication purposes.
- Team name to be recorded on Team Registration sheet. Team names are not to include reference in any form to a school. Team name will only be changed after registration if we have duplicate team names.
- Netball Victoria Regulations require any adult in a position of responsibility including coaches, team managers and umpires to maintain a valid Working with Children Check and must provide evidence to WNA before the first round.

2020 PLAYER, COACH and UMPIRE NETBALL VICTORIA MEMBERSHIP

- Players, coaches and umpires must register themselves online for their Netball Victoria and Wangaratta Netball Association registration via link on Wangaratta Netball Association website / Noticeboard page **OR** MyNetball App.
 - Download the free MyNetball App from the App Store or Google Play.
 - Once downloaded, login with your email address or MyNetball ID (same password and log in details as you use for registration process)
 - In "MY NETWORK" add WNA by typing in full association name
 - Click on "Star" beside League/Association to add to your network
- If you have any trouble registering please contact us via email wangnetball@westnet.com.au with player/coach/umpire name and date of birth. Email us if you require an email address updated.
- Team Manager responsible for ensuring WNA Committee has evidence of payment of 2020 Netball Victoria membership **before** players takes the court. All players will receive email confirmation of payment of Netball Victoria membership therefore it is important that your email address is correct.
- Participant packs will be distributed directly to each participant from the time of their NetSetGO registration. Please allow 21-28 days delivery after registration.
- Include Participant Pack T-shirt size on registration form and ensure address is correct.

Additional Information – Team Managers/Coaches

Conduct of Game

- NetSetGo players cannot play in the Junior competition.
- Coach or Team Manager must report to clubrooms and confirm the number of players available on game day at least 10 minutes prior to scheduled game start time.
- Coach or Team Manager collects the bibs and size 4 game ball for court when reporting.

- No jewellery, earrings or adornment may be worn during the game. Taping of nails or jewellery is not allowed. Please support the umpires in enforcing these rules.
- All players to be in appropriate uniform when taking the court (Girls-skirt; Boys-sport shorts plus polo shirt or t-shirt) in the same colour. Long sleeved tops and leggings permitted during cold weather.
- Only NetSetGo coaches are allowed to coach along sidelines BUT must not interfere with the umpire when providing players with immediate feedback.
- New Junior umpires may complete their practical court time in the NetSetGo program and we request that you assist and encourage them in this extremely challenging role as they learn.
- All players should receive equal court time during the season and have the opportunity/encouraged to play all different positions.
- Only in NetSetGO can players be moved from one team to another to ensure a game can be played. Wangaratta Netball Association's aim is to maximize on court practice as part of learning for NetSetGO players.

Injury

- In NetSetGo games the umpires should use their own discretion when allowing a player to return to the game. This applies to players arriving late as well as players who have left the game for injury or under the blood policy.
- All injuries to be reported to the Clubrooms and an Injury Incident form completed at the discretion of the injured player or players' guardian.
- Blood rule – any player who is bleeding must be removed from the court immediately to be attended too.
